1. **Zany** – amusingly unconventional or eccentric.
2. **Zealous** – showing great enthusiasm or passion.
3. **Zestful** – full of energy and enthusiasm.
4. **Zesty** – having a strong, pleasant, and lively flavor or character.
5. **Zigzag** – having sharp turns or angles alternating in direction.
6. **Zincous** – relating to or containing zinc.
7. **Zippy** – lively, energetic, or fast.
8. **Zonal** – relating to or divided into zones or areas.
9. **Zoned** – divided into zones, especially for specific uses.
10. **Zenithal** – relating to the highest point or zenith.
11. **Zephyrous** – like a gentle, mild breeze.
12. **Zeolitic** – relating to zeolites, a group of minerals.
13. **Zephyrian** – of or relating to the west wind.
14. **Zephyric** – pertaining to or resembling a zephyr (a soft breeze).
15. **Zirconic** – relating to zirconium or its compounds.
16. **Zirconiferous** – containing or bearing zircon.
17. **Zymurgic** – relating to fermentation, especially brewing.
18. **Zymogenous** – producing fermentation.
19. **Zealful** – full of zeal or enthusiasm.
20. **Zionist** – relating to Zionism or supporters of a Jewish homeland.
21. **Zoophagous** – feeding on animals.

- 23. **Zoophobic** – having a fear of animals.
- 24. **Zootechnic** – relating to the science of breeding and caring for domestic animals.
- 25. **Zootic** – pertaining to animals or animal diseases.
- 26. **Zymolytic** – relating to or causing fermentation.
- 27. **Zymotic** – caused by fermentation or relating to infectious diseases.
- 28. **Zygodactyl** – having toes arranged in pairs, two facing forward and two backward.
- 29. **Zygomantic** – relating to the cheekbone.
- 30. **Zygomorphic** – having bilateral symmetry, especially in flowers.
- 31. **Zymogenic** – causing or producing fermentation.
- 32. **Zygotic** – relating to a zygote, the cell formed by the fusion of two gametes.
- 33. **Zygospheric** – relating to a zygosphere, a structure in certain protozoa.
- 34. **ZygospERMous** – having seeds formed by the fusion of two gametes.
- 35. **Zygosporic** – relating to zygosporES, a type of spore formed by the fusion of gametes.
- 36. **Zygotene** – relating to a stage in meiosis where chromosomes begin to pair.
- 37. **Zygapophysial** – relating to the zygapophysis, a part of a vertebra.
